Common Name	Description
Babcock	Best known white peach; sweet, juicy; heavy bearer.
Bonanza - Miniature	Large fruit with a mild flavor; 5 - 6' tree.
Elberta	Large peach with rich, sweet flavor; yellow flesh; best all-purpose peach. Ripens in late July (Gleason Elberta Early ripens in early July; Fay Elberta Late ripens in August)
Empress - Miniature	Very sweet, juicy; yellow flesh; hardiest of dwarfs; clingstone; 4 -5 ' tree.
Fairtime	Late season producer; yellow flesh.
Forty Niner	Medium to large fruit; firm, sweet with yellow flesh.
Frost	Medium to large fruit; yellow flesh with excellent sweet flavor; resistant to peach leaf curl.
Hale Haven	Large fruit; yellow flesh; great for fresh eating and canning.
Harken	Sweet, yellow flesh; medium-sized fruit.
Indian Blood	White flesh streaked with red; heavy producer; clingstone.
Nectar	Large fruit; firm, sweet and juicy; white flesh.
O'Henry	Yellow flesh; large fruit; heavy-bearer.
Pix Zee - Miniature	Large fruit with firm, yellow flesh; 6' tree.
Polly White	Medium fruit; white flesh; very juicy; best white peach for cold climates.
Ranger	Sweet, yellow flesh; large fruit; good for cold climates; late blooming.
Red Baron	Large fruit; juicy, firm, yellow flesh.
Red Haven	Medium to large fruit; firm, sweet with yellow flesh; good for cold climates.
Veteran	Flavorful, yellow fruit; blooms late so a good choice for cold climates.

Plant 20' apart. All are self-fertile and freestone unless noted.
